They will also assist with Salesforce data projects and will assist with other small tasks relating to the preparation of our monthly financial statements. The Events and Engagement intern will have the chance to attend several community events with the United Way team.

Primary responsibilities will include assisting with:

- Financial projections evaluating trends & variances
- Data management projects
- Collecting, evaluating and interpreting financial data in statistical and narrative form
- United Way finance committee and board meetings as schedule allows.
- Other activities to further the reach of United Way in our community.

Student Requirements:

- One year of coursework already completed in a business, finance, or accounting course of studies is preferable
- Good written and oral communication skills are necessary
- Must be capable of maintaining records and documentation
- Experience related to financial management and entering/verifying data, particularly with Salesforce, is beneficial but not required

United Way will foster a learning environment by providing hands-on experience in the nonprofit sector. The Finance & Data Management Intern will work alongside and report directly to the United Way Director.
